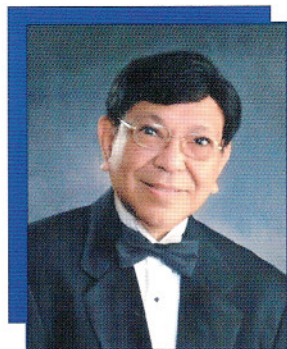


# QUO VADIS?
